

The Impact of Sports Premium Funding 2015-16

The sports Premium Funding has been used to improve the quality of PE Teaching at the school as well as to encourage the children's participation in sport. New equipment has been purchased and the children were entered into a wide variety of competitions.

Purchasing of new equipment

New equipment has been purchased for the school. This has included footballs, netballs, basketballs and tennis balls to restock for the new curriculum.

Inter-school competitions

Entrance fees have been paid to enter the children in a wide range of competitions including football, tag rugby, cross-country and Town Sports. This has enabled competition with other schools and for the children to take pride in representing St Michael's, on a wider stage. This has included: Football tournaments for Year 5 & 6 (boys and girls) and Year 6 in a football league; Year 5 & 6 Netball; Year 5 & 6 Swimming Gala; Year 3 & 4 Cricket and Cross country.

Training for Staff

Two members of St Michael's Teaching Staff are continuing to attend a two-year Sports Leadership Award, which started in March 2014 and finishes in December 2015. The qualification aims to upskill primary school teachers through a recognised qualification that will improve the overall delivery of the physical education curriculum within primary schools. Also another member of staff has been attending a Level 5 Certificate of Physical Education.
