

## **Sports Premium Funding Plan 2016-17**

The plan for funding of sport using the Sport Premium grant is as follows:

### **Purchasing of new equipment**

New equipment is to be purchased to continue to support the curriculum and a netball court is to be created on the playground.

### **Inter-school competitions**

Entrance fees have been paid to enter the children in a wide range of competitions including football, tag rugby, cross-country, netball, swimming and Town Sports. This has enabled competition with other schools and for the children to take pride in representing St Michael's, on a wider stage.

### **Training for Staff**

A member of staff has been trained up to Level 5 in PE and will continue to be supported to obtain the Level 6 qualification. A PE Instructor is training all teaching staff to use the new curriculum that has been introduced (designed by our Sports Specialist TA). This will include termly teaching sessions for the teachers and support in assessing and recording pupil progress.

### **Active Literacy/Mathematics**

In Autumn 2 this programme is to be introduced to help raise reading, writing and mathematics results. Based on the latest research this PE initiative that will take place in English and Mathematics lessons will help children build core strength and reinvigorate them to help with concentration. The main expenditure will be on equipment for the classrooms (bean bags).
