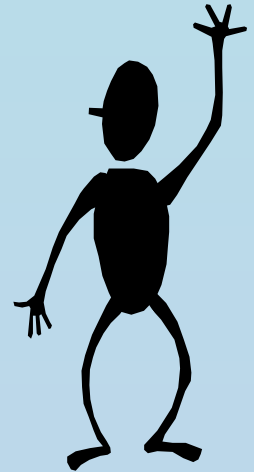

Reading Book System

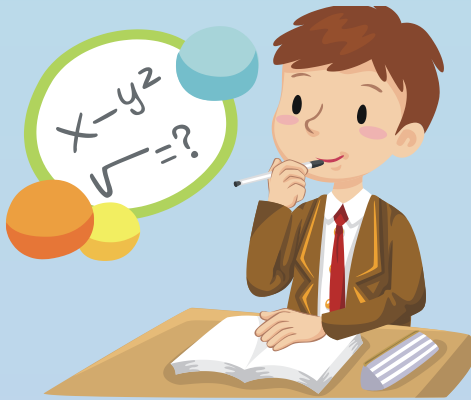
- ❖ Bring every day

Spellings

There is a big emphasis on spelling in the Year 2 Curriculum.

As a first approach, children are taught to 'sound out' using phonics knowledge.

As they become more confident readers and writers, they are encouraged to spot 'words within words' and to LEARN common words that can't be sounded out.
