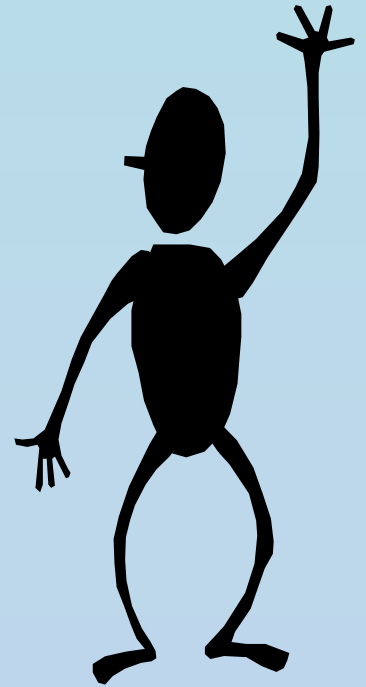

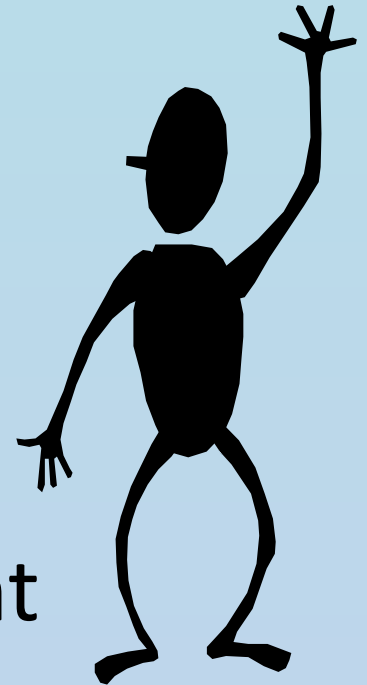

 - Reading Record needs to be signed at least 3 times a week.

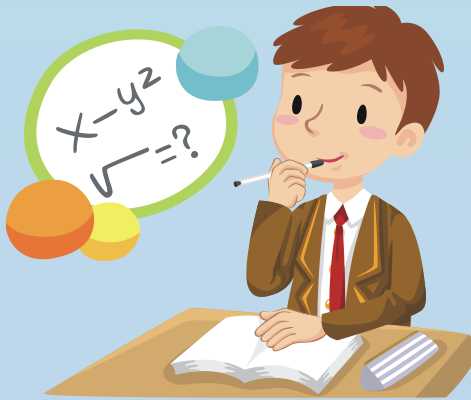


Uniform

****Focus on presentation of work****

All children will start the term using a pencil. If they consistently join and present their work to a high standard they will be awarded a pen license.

Times tables

Every Friday the children will be tested on their times tables. They have the challenge of answering 40 questions in 3 minutes to help improve their recall. Everyone will start at their 2x table first, if they answer all 40 or 39 correctly they will then move onto the next challenge.

Reading ...

Every Tuesday year 3 will have a reading club at lunchtime where children can come and choose to read inside the classroom. If a child hasn't read three times in a week, at home and had their diary signed, they will have the opportunity to have this time on a Tuesday.

Read three times a week or more – Choose to come

Read two times a week – 10 minutes

Read once a week – 20 minutes

Doesn't read in a week – 30 minutes

To reward those amazing readers we have Pokedex with pokemon stickers.

Last year this was a massive success to encourage those readers.

If your child reads more than the expected amount and reads 5 times a week they get one sticker.

If they read 7 times in a week they are given two.
