- ⦿ More responsibility is expected from the children.
- ⦿ They will be able to sign up for various activities only available for Y6 children; office duties, recycling monitors
- ⦿ We are going paperless so please frequently check the school website for updates.

WORKLOAD INCREASE

- ⦿ Ensure your child has enough sleep.
- ⦿ A healthy diet.
- ⦿ Plan homework times.
- ⦿ Make time for fun and relaxation.

Our own data shows the less than 95% attendance negatively affects the outcome for children.

HOMework

- Children should know what their homework is and when it must be completed. It is set on a Monday and will need to be completed by the following Monday.
- Reading to a parent (or sustained silent reading) at least three times a week for a period of 20 - 30 minutes
- Spellings to learn, set and tested on a weekly basis (on a Monday).
- One written numeracy task, mymaths activities and times tables to be learnt in preparation for a weekly test (on a Friday).

OTHER YEAR 6 INFORMATION

- ◉ SATs - Week beginning May 14th
- ◉ Consists of a reading test, EPAG test (English, Punctuation and Grammar), arithmetic test and 2 maths reasoning papers.
- ◉ Writing levels are assessed within school and may be moderated.
- ◉ We may be included in a science test sample.
- ◉ Ferny Crofts 25th -29th June. The first letter will go out in January and the first meeting is in February.
- ◉ **Secondary transition- date to be confirmed**
- ◉ **We will have further meetings about SATs and Ferny Croft nearer the time.**

REWARDS

- ◉ Golden Time - Fridays, a reward for keeping the Golden Rules.
- ◉ Merit points awarded for behaviour and work. Earn bronze, silver and gold certificates.
- ◉ Attendance certificate.
- ◉ At times stickers or other certificates.
- ◉ Celebration assembly
- ◉ Year assembly awards

UNIFORM REMINDER

- ◉ PE is on Monday and Wednesday
- ◉ PE kit - yellow t-shirt, blue shorts, plimsols/trainers. In colder weather- tracksuits.
