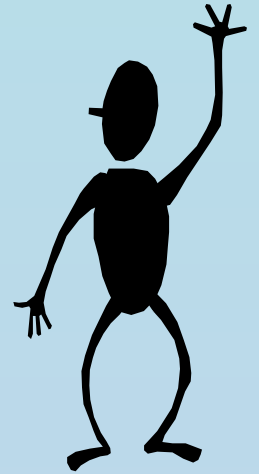

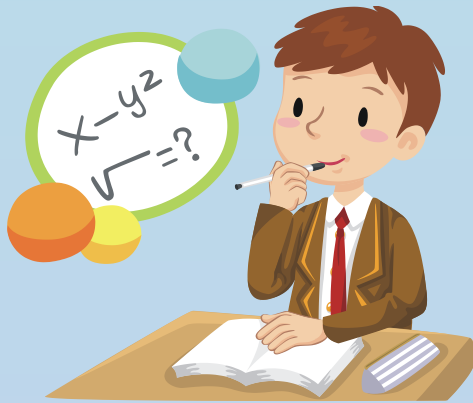
What's new?

It's All About You !

Topic Overview

During this topic the children will learn all about themselves and the parts of the body. They will learn about the 5 senses and which parts of the body they are associated with. They will also share information about their families and things that are important to them.

Focus subjects

Science – Senses (hearing, sight, taste, smell and touch) and parts of the body.

Art - Using a range of mediums, the children will be creating pictures of themselves and their families.

Literacy – Writing sentences and talking about themselves and their family.

The hook for this topic is our visit to Build-A-Bear!

Outcome

The children will be having a 'Sensory Workshop' that you are invited to attend. This will include games that involve using your senses and will be an opportunity to look at your child's work.

Spelling

Children will be given spellings weekly. New spellings and tests will take place on **Fridays**. These will begin Friday 21st September (with the first test on Friday 29th) and will link to your child's phonics. Please help them to practice these spellings at home.

Trips

Our trip is to Build-A-Bear!

1AH—Thursday 13th September (10- 12)
1MS— Friday 14th September (9- 11)

The children will have fun choosing and designing a class bear which will become the 'class mascot'. Each child will have a chance to take the class bear home for a weekend and to share stories from their weekend with the class.

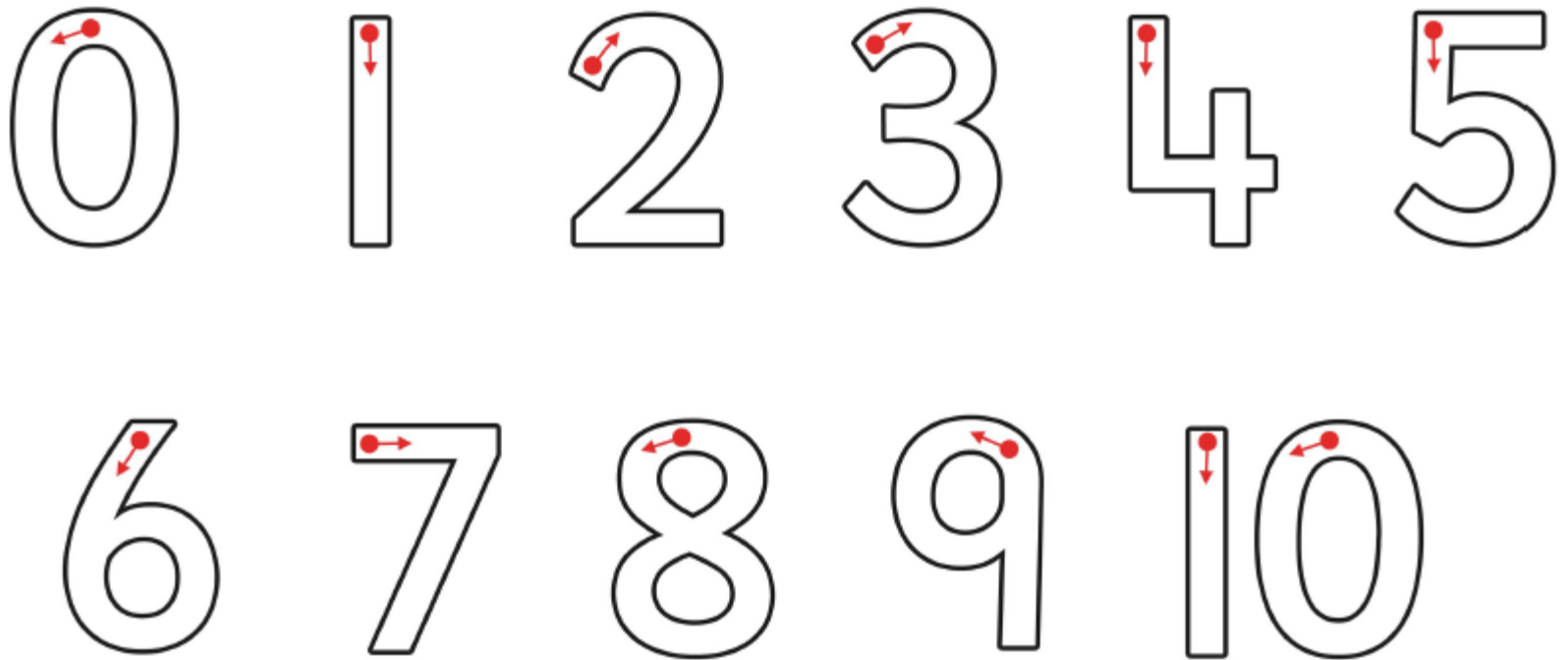

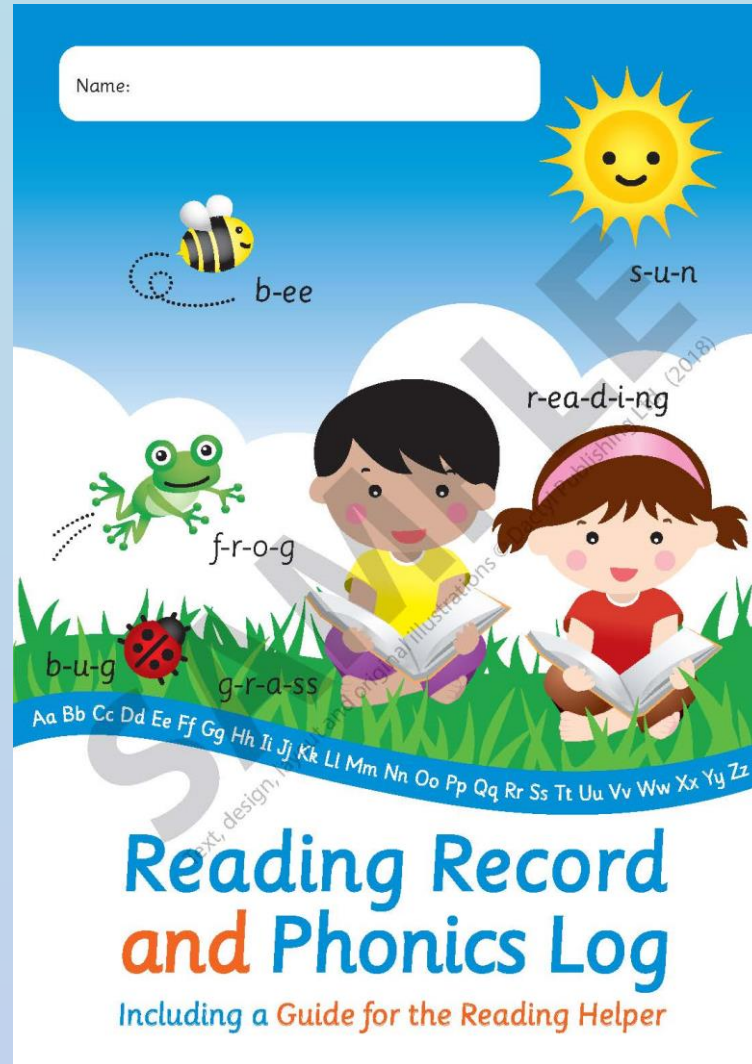
