PARKING PERMITS

There are two car parks within walking distance of the school at Durley Road and West Hill Road. You can purchase a parking permit for £15 for the year, which will permit you to park in either car park for a set period at the beginning and end of the day in order to drop-off or pick-up your child. OUT OF HOURS CHILD CARE

Breakfast Club will continue running next year.

Please note however, that access to the breakfast club will be via our gates on West Hill Road.

Breakfast will not be served after 8:00am and the gates will be locked at 8:15am.

We will no longer be taking bookings on the day.

If you require a place in our breakfast club, you must book on Wisepay in advance and no later than 3:00pm the day before.

After School Club will resume running from September.

Places are limited to 45 and you must book a place on Wisepay in advance and no later than 9:00am on the day.

Summer Holiday Club

Child care provision will run during the summer holidays and can be booked on Wisepay.

Please note that places are limited and will be given on a first come basis.
